

# **National Pan-Hellenic Council Membership Intake Process**

Each NPHC member organization is responsible for their own membership intake program. Please note that the Membership Intake Process can vary from group to group and information about NPHC organizations will be given to prospective members at the Fall Block Party scheduled for Thursday, August 25, 2011 at 7:00 PM in Bayou Park. There is no charge to attend the Informational and individuals who are interested in becoming a member are encouraged to attend. The attire for the event is professional dress.

Membership into NPHC fraternities and sororities is based upon possession of qualifications of the applicants. To be considered for Membership Intake, a candidate must first complete an NPHC Informational Application and pay a \$10 application fee. This does not guarantee membership into any organization. Please keep in mind that individual grade point averages and semester hour requirements vary with each organization. Many organizations also require letters of recommendation and documented community service hours.
